## Writing

- Write different kinds of sentence: statements, questions, exclamations, and commands.
- Use expanded noun phrases to add description and specification For example, changing "The house..." into "The spooky house on the hill..."
- Write using subordination (when, if, that, because).
- Correct and consistent use of present tense and past tense.
- · Correct use of verb tenses.
- · Correct and consistent use of:
  - Capital letters.
  - Full stops.
  - Question marks.
  - Exclamation marks.

- Commas in a list.
- Apostrophe (omission).
- Introduction of inverted commas.
- · Write under headings.
- · Evidence of diagonal and horizontal strokes to join handwriting.

## Reading

- · Read ahead to help with fluency and expression.
- Comments on plot, setting and characters in familiar and unfamiliar stories.
- Recounts main themes and events.
- · Comments on structure of the text.
- Use commas, question marks and exclamation marks to vary expression.
- Read aloud with expression and intonation.
- · Recognise:
  - inverted commas
  - contractions
- · Identify past/present tense.
- Use contents and index to locate information.

## **Mathematics**

- Compare and order numbers up to 100.
- · Read and write all numbers to 100 in digits and words.
- · Say 10 more/less than any number to 100.
- Count in multiples of 2, 3, 5 and 10 from any number up to 100.
- · Recall and use multiplication and division facts for 2, 5 and 10 tables.
- · Recall and use +/- facts to 20.
- · Derive and use related facts to 100.
- Recognise PV of any 2-digit number.
- · Add and subtract:
  - 2-digit numbers
  - Three 1-digit numbers
- Recognise and use inverse (+/-).
- Calculate and write multiplication and division calculations using multiplication tables.
