

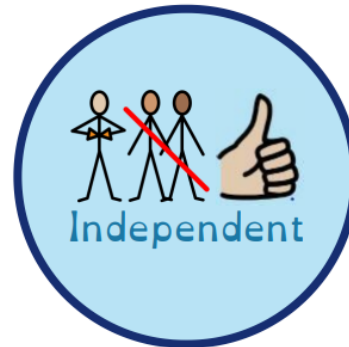


Character Education at Raglan Primary School

Character Education is a learning process that enables children and adults within the school community to understand, care about and act on core ethical values such as respect, justice, citizenship and responsibility for self and others.

At Raglan we use Character Education Virtues to provide children with opportunities to help explore and express character, build the skills needed for resilience, empathy and ultimately being able to get a job, and be a positive citizen in our community.

Our Raglan Character Education Virtues



Character education is taught through:

- PSHE lessons
- British Values

Character education is promoted weekly through:

- Star of the Week – Star of the Week will be linked to the relevant character education virtue.
- Newsletter – the virtue of the week will be promoted in the Newsletter.

Children will be told at the start of each week which Character Education Virtue is character of the week.
