This term, our topic continues to be Toys and Games. The children will be covering different texts, such as 'Traction Man is Here', 'Supertato' and 'Jumanji.'

The children will continue to work on their story sequencing and story telling skills, as well as developing their writing in a range of different ways including instruction writing, narrative, non-chronological reports, a wanted and lost toy poster, as well as non-fiction.

The children will also be developing their handwriting and fine motor skills through a range of activities in our continuous provision.

Phonics will be taught 4 times a week, according to which phase your child is in. During English lessons, children are encouraged to use their Phonics to support their spelling and grammar.

Home Learning

Home learning will continue to be set in home learning books, in the form of a learning jigsaw of activities.

All of the activities set are linked to the curriculum being taught in the provision this half term.

Please ensure one piece of learning is completed per week and is sent in on Monday of each week.
