We would appreciate it if you could ask them questions about what they are reading e.g. What is this paragraph about? What do you think will happen next? How has the author described one of the characters? Please sign the record book each time. Please could you also encourage your child to complete the weekly spelling activities. Maths - Please support your child in learning their times tables and identifying their division facts. Many children need further support to tell the time using analogue time, including using the 24 hour clock. Maths concepts can be consolidated by encouraging children to regularly go on Mathletics.
