In English we will be exploring ...

Secret of R

Lila and the Secret of Rain by David Conway, the story of a young girl who tries to save her

village from the terrible drought. We will writing a setting description, diary entry in role as Lila, retelling the story from Lila's perspective, writing rain songs and writing our own version of the story. We will be learning about using varied vocabulary and writing noun phrases. We will continue to use different punctuation, including apostrophes for contractions and possession and a variety of conjunctions (but, because, so, if, when, or) in our writing. We will be continuing to focus on spelling words using the suffixes -ful, -ment, -ness, -ly. In Phonics, we will be learning the Phase 6 alternative graphemes.

As mathematicians, we will be...

- Recapping how to tell the time to the hour and half past the hour
- Learning quarter past and quarter to the hour
- Telling the time to 5 minutes intervals, both past and to the hour
- Understanding that there are 60 minutes in a hour and applying this to solve problems
- Exploring the number of hours in a day
- Focussing on measuring lengths and heights using a ruler, metre sticks and tape measures
- Comparing and ordering the length and heights of objects

How can you help at home?

- Encourage your child to read the time on an analogue clock to o'clock, half past, quarter to and quarter past the hour and talk about the time of day.
- Encourage children to use measuring equipment at home such as, rulers, weighing scales and measuring jugs to secure their knowledge of reading different scales and becoming familiar with different units of measurement ie. cm, m, g, kg, ml and l.
- When walking around the local area, discuss the different human and physical features and even use a map to navigate short routes!

In Science we will.....

- Continue with our unit: Investigating Living Things
- Make observations of local microhabitats and the creatures that live there
- Understand how living things adapt to their habitat
- Describe how animals obtain their food from plants and other animals

In RE we will

- Explore the question: How important is it for Jewish people to do what God tells them to do?
- Learn about the significance of Passover
- Learn about how Passover is celebrated and the items on a Seder plate

In PE we will

- Work with Coach Alhaji on making it difficult for opponents to score points and to choose specific tactics in team games
- Develop power, agility, coordination and balance
- Negotiate obstacles showing increased control

In Geography we will.....

- Identify human and physical features in our local area
- Use OS maps and aerial photographs to gather information about our local area
- Create our own maps of the local area including a simple key
- Follow a route on a map to move around the local area
- Carry out fieldwork to observe the local area and answer a geographical question
