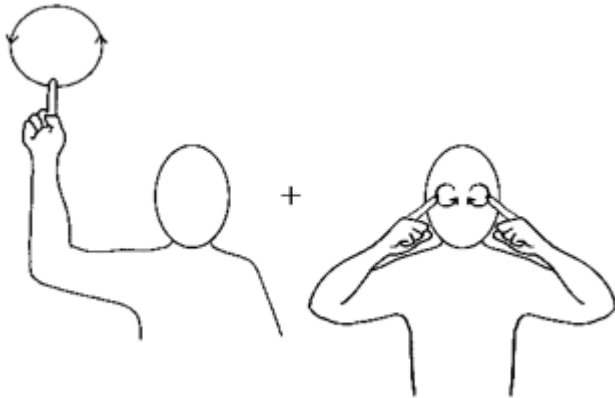

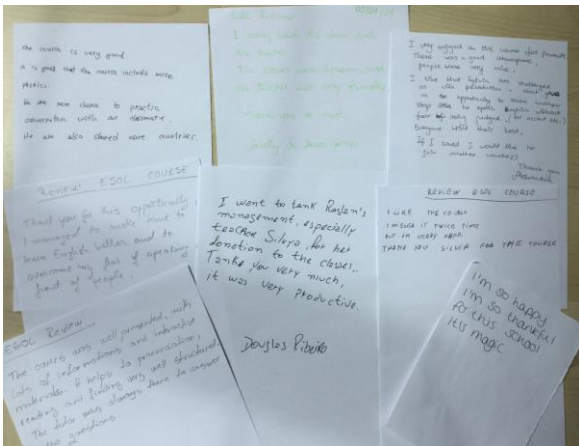


ESOL
