As mathematicians we will... Practise doubling numbers up to 20, sharing amounts between different groups, beginning to identify odd and even numbers and explore patterns and spatial reasoning further.

Phonics... During our **phonics sessions** the children will continue to use their phase 3 sounds and some of us will move into learning Phase 4 sounds.

Please continue practising reading and writing digraphs at home with your children as they still get a little muddled when reading and when applying it to their writing. Encourage them to write sentences using words with these digraphs and reading it back to you. We are practicing writing using a capital letter at the beginning of the sentence, finger spaces, and a punctuation at the end.

Reception Key Information

- P.E will take place every Monday and Wednesday so please ensure children have their full kit which includes; navy shorts/ jogging bottoms/leggings, navy t. shirt and plimsolls that are labelled.
- Forest school will take place on a Tuesday for Monkey Class and on a Thursday for Lion Class. Children will need to come in to school dressed in their own clothes for their allocated session.
